

The **Enhanced Bolt Release** (EBR-Universal) is designed for use with many competition shotguns to enlarge the bolt release surface for faster port loads.

### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN:**

*This part is designed to be installed to an existing drilled/tapped bolt release on your auto-loading shotgun. If your shotgun does not have a drilled/tapped bolt release it is strongly recommended this installation be done by a competent gunsmith. Factory releases are typically a hardened part that is not easily drilled/tapped with consumer grade tools.*

Make absolutely sure that your shotgun is unloaded before installation of the EBR. Ensure there are no rounds in the magazine tube and that the chamber has been visually inspected to make sure it is clear. Ensure the bolt is closed as well.

### **INSTALLATION:**

Set the Enhanced Bolt Release over the drilled/tapped factory bolt release button, checking for fit and proper clearances. Install the button to the factory release using a proper flat-head machine screw for your application. A 6-32 machine screw is included with your EBR-Universal in order to facilitate installation with this most common thread pattern.

Once you have tested the part for proper function and are satisfied with position, you can disassemble the part, apply a drop of blue thread locking compound to the EBR's threads and reassemble. Do NOT over tighten!

### **MAINTENANCE:**

After the first 100 rounds, check that the Enhanced Bolt Release hasn't come loose. Finish wear may develop in areas that come in contact with the receiver or other objects. This is normal and will not affect function of the EBR or shotgun.
