

The **Enhanced Competition Follower** (ECF) is intended for use in competition 12 Gauge shotguns to improve visibility of the unloaded state of your magazine tube. The ECF also provides a smoother transition across factory or aftermarket extended magazine tube joints.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN:

Make absolutely sure that your Mossberg shotgun is unloaded before installation of the Enhanced Competition Follower. Ensure there are no rounds in the magazine tube and that the chamber has been visually inspected to make sure it is clear. Safety glasses should be worn during the installation process.

If you are not familiar with the disassembly of your Mossberg shotgun, this part should be installed by a qualified gunsmith. Refer to your shotgun's owner's manual for detailed disassembly and cleaning instructions. If you do not have an owner's manual, you should obtain one from Mossberg before proceeding.

INSTALLATION:

The part being replaced by the Alloy ECF is listed in your Mossberg's manual as the 'Magazine Follower'. If the ECF does NOT slide easily into your magazine tube, inspect for excessive buildup of dirt or damage to the tube. Check your specific spring fitment with the follower before reassembling the gun. Once your shotgun is reassembled, thoroughly test loading and proper feeding before placing the gun back into service, whether competition or otherwise.

MAINTENANCE:

After the first 100 rounds, disassemble your shotgun and check the ECF for any abnormal wear points. Clean the ECF and push a cleaning patch through your magazine tube after each exposure to adverse weather or dirty conditions.
